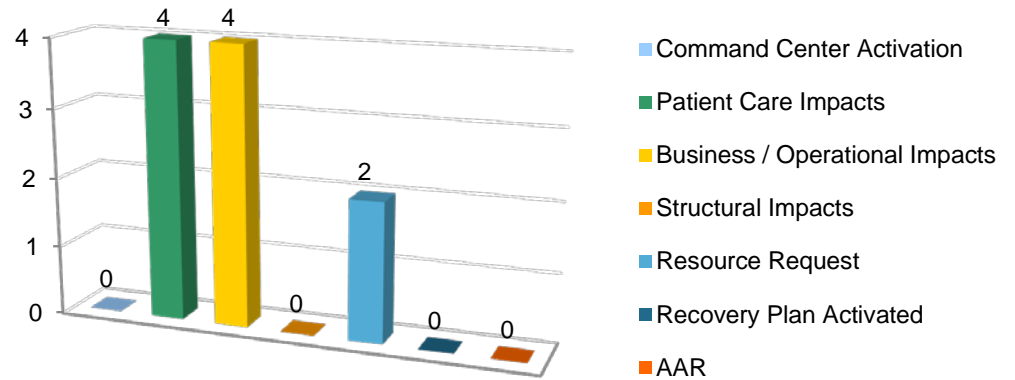

| 06/30/21 | Technological | Evacuation | External | Suffolk Towers Apartments | Email | No | No | No | No | Yes | No | Unknown | 07/26/21 | Suffolk Towers Apartments, a multi story complex on North Main St. has been evacuated because of a water leak that has shut off power to the building. A shelter for those unable to find other arrangements will open at Kings Fork High School at 1700. 118 persons displaced. WTHD Emergency Coordinator and PHN's assisting. Facility is home to many low income and elderly residents. Impact compounded by extreme heat. |
| 07/23/21 | Human | Infectious Disease Outbreak | External | Eastern | Email | No | No | No | No | No | No | Unknown | 08/23/21 | Peninsula ED reports 3 incidents of pt's presenting with seizures after having used marijuana. There is no known association between these individuals. Poison Control notified and alerted Office of Epidemiology. Law Enforcement has sent samples for analysis, results pending. |
| 07/29/21 | Technological | Communication / Telephony Failure | Internal | Bon Secours Southampton Medical Center | Email | No | No | Yes | No | No | No | No | 07/30/21 | Communication phone lines are currently down, reason unknown. Unable to receive incoming phone calls and unable to make outgoing phone calls using the facility's land line system. |
| 08/31/21 | Natural | Hurricane | External | Statewide | Email | No | No | No | No | No | No | Unknown | 10/28/21 | As Tropical Depression Ida moves Northeast across the Commonwealth, there is a continued threat of heavy rain and flooding along its path. | 12/03/21 | Human | Supply Chain Shortage / Failure | Internal | Riverside Regional | Email | No | Yes | No | No | No | No | No | 12/14/21 | Riverside Regional Medical Center is experiencing a critically low supply of type O blood products. There are no supplies available from our normal vendors of these products. They are concerned that one massive transfusion protocol will exhaust our supply. This would force us to consider the diversion of any additional trauma patients to other trauma centers. |
